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billy beede the teenage daughter of the fast running no account and six years dead willa mae comes home one day to find a fateful letter waiting for her willa mae s burial spot in lajunta arizona is about to be plowed up to make way for a supermarket as willa mae s only daughter billy is heiress to her mother s substantial but unconfirmed fortune a cache of jewels that willa mae s lover dill smiles is said to have buried with her dirt poor living in a trailer with her aunt june and uncle roosevelt behind a gas station in a tumbleweedy texas town and pregnant with an illegitimate child billy knows that treasure could mean salvation so she steals dill s pickup truck and with her aunt and uncle in tow

heads for arizona with dill in hot pursuit while everyone agrees it s only polite to speak of getting mother s body and moving her to a proper resting place it s well understood that digging up willa mae s diamonds and pearls will make the whole trip a lot more worthwhile the enormously accomplished fiction debut from suzan lori parks the 2002 winner of the pulitzer prize for drama getting mother s body takes its place in the company of the classic works of zora neale hurston and alice walker but when it comes to an ingenious uproarious knack for depicting the trifling hard luck down and out souls who need a little singing and laughing and lying and praying to get through the day suzan lori parks shares the stage with no one

western culture has long regarded black female sexuality with a strange mix of fascination and condemnation associating it with everything from desirability hypersexuality and liberation to vulgarity recklessness and disease yet even as their bodies and sexualities have been the subject of countless public discourses black women s voices have been largely marginalized in these discussions in this groundbreaking collection feminist scholars from across the academy come together to correct this omission illuminating black female sexual desires marked by agency and empowerment as well as pleasure and pain to reveal the ways black women regulate their sexual lives the twelve original essays in black female sexualities reveal the diverse ways black women perceive experience and represent sexuality the contributors highlight the range of tactics that black women use to express their sexual desires and identities yet they do not shy away from exploring the complex ways in which black women negotiate the more traumatic aspects of sexuality and grapple with the legacy of negative stereotypes black female sexualities takes not only an interdisciplinary approach drawing from critical race theory sociology and performance studies but also an intergenerational one in conversation with the foremothers of black feminist studies in addition it explores a diverse archive of representations covering everything from blues to hip hop from crash to precious from sister souljah to edwidge danticat revealing that black female sexuality is anything but a black and white issue this collection demonstrates how to appreciate a whole spectrum of subjectivities experiences and desires

missing dead disappeared or otherwise absent mothers haunt us and the stories we tell ourselves our literature from fairytales like cinderella and the little mermaid to popular narratives like cheryl strayed s recent book wild is peopled with motherless children the

absent mother whether in literature or life may force us to forge an independent identity but she can also leave a mother shaped hole and a howling loneliness that dogs us through our adult lives this anthology explores the theme of absent mothers from scholars and creative writers who tell personal stories and provide the theoretical framework to recognize and begin to understand the impact of motherlessness that ripples through our cultures and our art

understanding suzan lori parks is a critical study of a playwright and screenwriter who was the first african american woman to receive the pulitzer prize for drama suzan lori parks is also the recipient of a macarthur genius award a whiting writers award a calarts alpert award in the arts two obie awards and a eugene mcdermott award in the arts in this book jennifer laron examines how parks through the innovative language and narratives of her extensive body of work investigates and invigorates literary and cultural history laron discusses all of parks s genres play screenplay essay and novel closely reading key texts from parks s more experimental earlier pieces as well as her more linear later narratives laron s study begins with a survey of parks s earliest and most difficult texts including imperceptible mutabilities in the third kingdom and the death of the last black man in the whole entire world laron then analyzes venus in the blood and the lincoln plays the america play and the pulitzer prize winning topdog underdog laron also discusses two of parks s most important screenplays girl 6 and their eyes were watching god in interpreting these screenplays laron examines film s role in the popularization and representation of african american culture and history these essays suggest an approach to all genres of literature and blend creativity form culture and history into a revisionary aesthetic that allows for no identity or history to remain fixed with parks arguing that in order to be relevant they must all be dynamic and democratic
